When I first learned of GWI through a foundation meeting in Moscow, little did I know this would be the beginning of God's call on my life to serve Him in Moldova. A few years later, our ministry began when 51 eager participants from 14 churches attended our very first leadership training seminar in Moldova.

Afterward, Olya shared:

"The course I liked the most was on reaching deeply troubled children whose hearts are closed. Through hearing the teacher's reallife experiences, I gained the tools I needed to come alongside struggling children with help and hope in Jesus."

Over the past years, since 2012, we have:

- Held 11 training seminars for 940 camp and church leaders from over 30 churches.
- Organized camps in 10 regions of our country that have served 23,000 children from non-Christian families.
- Conducted city-wide Kids Games sports events that have reached over 10,000 youth.

 Reached countless kids who have called in to listen to Bible stories that are recorded on the "Alo Friend" answering machine.

With each project and camp, hearts have embraced faith in Jesus, and have gained life-long Christian principles that are now changing families, friends, and even their communities.

Whether the children GWI has reached with the Gospel in Moldova are young or old, I can think of no greater joy than hearing that these "children" are now learning to walk in the Truth with Jesus!
